Youth Guidelines

All scheduled rehearsals must be attended.

No more than two absentees will be allowed per scheduled rehearsal for special events, one absentee allowed per scheduled monthly event. Everyone must attend the final rehearsal. In preparation for each rehearsal, listening/meditating on the music chosen is encouraged.

Must be on time!

If an emergency arises and you are going to be late, please notify the instructor as soon as possible. Excessive tardiness is unacceptable.

Solos will be given at the discretion of the instructor.

We are encouraging our youth to use their talents and instructing them in the ministry of dance/mime, we also want them to exemplify unity in ministry.

All youth must be actively involved in youth ministry.

We are training our youth in ministry and it is important that they are in an atmosphere where the Word of God is being taught. This will enhance their spiritual lives and their worship. Youth are required to be in church regularly.

Discipline is encouraged since it is vital within our rehearsal time-frame.

Rehearsals are designed for teaching and training. If discipline is a continuous problem, the teaching and training needed for ministry in dance/mime is being hindered.

Dress code for ministry:

All garments must be clean and neatly pressed

Loose fitting tops and bottoms

No hip huggers, low riders, or sagging pants

No stretch material or fitted shirts or pants

Sports bra or sports top under shirts if needed

No excessive jewelry

Tote bags or backpacks for accessories

Garment bags or plastic covering for garments (dancers)

Ballet shoes are required (dancers)

Black ballet shoes are required for young ladies/black socks for young men (mime)

Ties/gloves for ministry (mime)

Baby oil/baby wipes for removal of makeup (mime)

***** Youth will not be allowed to minister if their attire is not appropriate or if they do not have the required attire. ******

Auditions are mandatory for individuals interested in ministry.

All youth interested in the ministry of dance or mime must go through the audition process. After auditions, there will be a 6- to 8-week mandatory training session.

If you are unable to meet the specific guidelines you will be required to “sit out” of ministry for a period of time. Upon returning to ministry, you must meet with the Director and Assistant Director.
